Subject: New NPA 380 to Overlay NPA 614 (Ohio)

On June 27, 2001, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio (“Commission”) in case number 00-1260-TP-COI, approved an all-services distributed overlay as the relief method for the 614 NPA, which serves the central region of Ohio.

The new 380 NPA will serve the same geographic area currently served by the existing 614 NPA. Some of the counties to be served by the NPA 380 include Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Licking, Madison, Pickaway and Union. A map of the overlay area is attached.

In preparation for the introduction of the overlay and mandatory 10 or 11-digit dialing, the Commission ordered all service providers, except CMRS providers, to introduce a permissive dialing period beginning at 12:01 AM Eastern Time August 18, 2001. During the permissive dialing period, subscribers may dial local calls within the overlay area on either a 7-digit or 10 or 11-digit basis, but will be encouraged to dial 10 or 11-digits. The permissive period will end at 12:01 AM Eastern Time on September 21, 2002.

After the beginning of mandatory dialing on September 21, 2002, the dialing plan for the 380 and 614 NPAs will be as follows:

- All local calls will be dialed as 10-digits (NPA+NXX+XXXX) or 11-digits (1+NPA+NXX+XXXX).
- All toll calls will require the prefix “1” plus 10-digits (1+NPA+NXX+XXXX).
- All operator assisted calls, including credit card, collect, and third-party calls will require the prefix “0” plus 10-digits (0+NPA+NXX+XXXX).

All international and domestic carriers should ensure that the new 380 NPA has been activated throughout their networks prior to September 21, 2002. Test calls to verify the routing to the 380 NPA can be made by dialing 380-333-1234. The test number will be in service beginning August 18, 2001 through October 21, 2002. A recorded announcement will indicate that the test call has been successful completed.

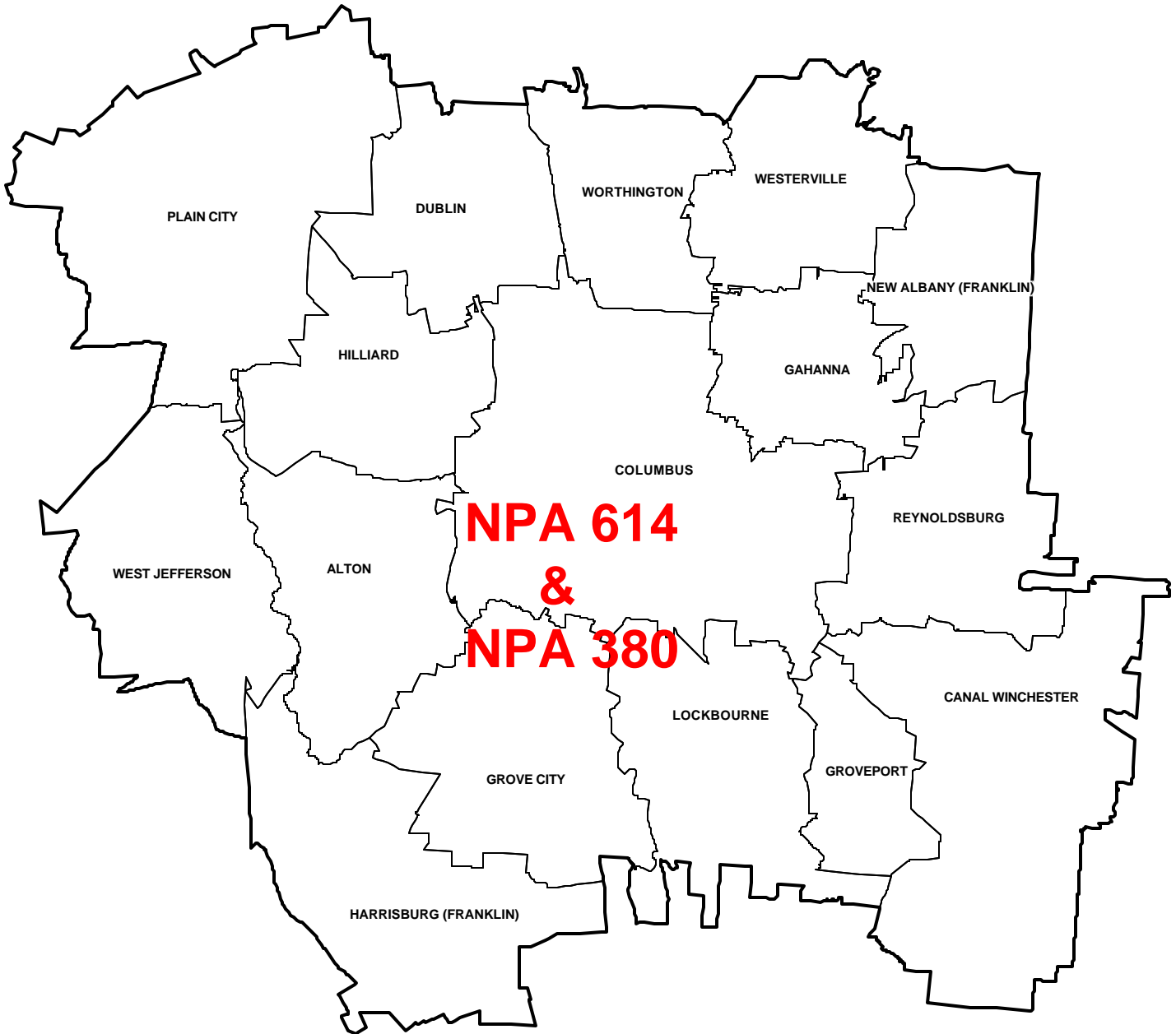


