Because NXX code demand has increased beyond industry forecast, the 787 NPA is in jeopardy of exhausting prior to when relief can be provided. According to the *Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines* (document INC 95-0407-008, revision 8/99), "A jeopardy condition exists when the forecasted and/or actual demand for NXX resources will exceed the known supply during the planning/implementation interval for relief." The Purpose of this notice is to announce that *extraordinary NPA-specific conservation* measures as defined in Section 8.5 of *the Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines* have become necessary for the 787 NPA.

All remaining codes in 787 NPA will be rationed through jeopardy procedures adopted via industry consensus on January 11, 2000, until relief is provided in accordance with a NPA relief plan yet to be developed. The jeopardy procedures have been posted to the NANPA web site, www.nanpa.com.
